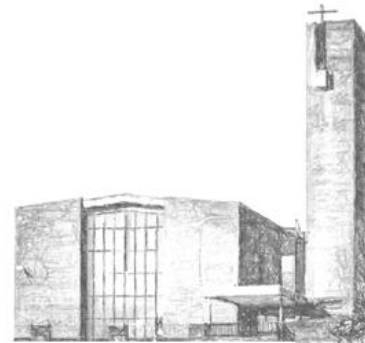

#### ASSISTED SUICIDE

In a pastoral letter addressed to all Scotland's Catholics, the bishops of Scotland have asked us all to urge MSPs to reject a proposed new law to legalise assisted suicide. The bishops describe the proposal put forward by Liam McArthur MSP, as "dangerous" and call on MSPs to focus their energies on improving palliative care which the bishops say is "underfunded and limited".
