

## **REFLECTION ON THE READINGS**

A rare example of Jesus' teaching where we hear his actual words. They are parables about the kingdom of God, about the growth of large plants from tiny seeds. The first focuses on seed germination. No one sees a seed growing until the shoot, and then the full plant emerges. The second reflects on the smallness of the mustard seed plant and the large shrub that it produces. Puzzling? Parables provoke questions; they don't provide answers!

The bishops describe the proposal put forward by Liam McArthur MSP, as "dangerous" and call on MSPs to focus their energies on improving palliative care which the bishops say is "underfunded and limited".
