

#### **REFLECTION ON THE READINGS**

On the Sea of Galilee during a storm, disciples are appalled. Jesus is asleep on a cushion. They wake him and shout "Do you not care? We are going down!". They are afraid of drowning. Jesus stands up and 'rebukes' the wind and the sea, i.e. with a word restores calm, and asks why they were so frightened: have they no faith? Jesus re-enacts what God did in Genesis: with a word, he controls the elements.

## **HUMAN TRAFFICKING**

This is an area of growing concern everywhere; some politicians say that there are victims of this in every town and village in Scotland. This week past, I discovered there is a patron saint for these poor souls, and I share with you some info from the Web.

Saint Josephine Bakhita was kidnapped and sold as a slave in Sudan at age seven. Her owner brought her to Italy where she became a babysitter. She eventually felt drawn to the Catholic Church. Her owners wanted to take her back to Sudan, but she refused. Slavery was illegal in Italy, so a court ruled her free. She later joined the Institute of St. Magdalene of Canossa religious community.

She is the patron saint of Sudan and human trafficking survivors.

# PRAYER FOR THE INTERCESSION OF SAINT JOSEPHINE BAKHITA:

"Saint Josephine Bakhita, you were sold into slavery as a child and endured untold hardship and suffering. Once liberated from your physical enslavement, you found true redemption in your encounter with Christ and his Church. O Saint Bakhita, assist all those who are trapped in a state of slavery. Intercede with God on their behalf so that they will be released from their chains of captivity. Those whom man enslaves, let God set free. Provide comfort to survivors of slavery and let them look to you as an example of hope and faith.
