
THIS WEEK'S READINGS

REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

Turning water into wine has nothing to do with the wedding; it is a sign demonstrating the power of Jesus' word to transform the human condition. Notice that he, the Word-madeflesh, does not actually do anything: his Word has power. His mother has implicit trust in the Word: she tells the servants: "do whatever he tells you"
