

## REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

'Baptism' literally means 'immersion'. Before his ministry begins, Jesus immerses himself in water as a sign that he immerses himself in the will of God, Father, Son and Spirit. This is the only time in the Bible where the Trinity is manifested in ways that humans can recognise. The Father's voice is heard; the Son is in human form, and the Spirit is visible as a dove. Here, among humans, is God, visible, audible and tangible.
