

THIS WEEK'S READINGS

READING 1 JER 17:5-8

A curse on the man who puts his trust in man, a blessing on the man who puts his trust in the Lord.

PSALM PS 1:1-4. 6 R. PS 39:5

Happy the man who has placed his trust in the Lord.

READING 2 1 COR 15:12, 16-20

If Christ has not been raised, your believing is useless.

GOSPEL LUKE 6:17. 20-26

How happy are you who are poor. Alas for you who are rich.

REFLECTION ON THE READINGS

Luke's version of the beatitudes and the Sermon they belong to gets under way. In Luke, Jesus descends from a mountain and teaches the crowds at ground level. Here, each 'beatitude/blessing' addressed to the poor and the suffering is counted by a warning to the rich, self-absorbed. Luke's version displays more typical traits of how a Jewish teacher of the Law might work: comparing and contrasting traits - poverty and riches, hunger and plenty, tears and rejoicing!
